Countable Nouns

- ✓ Can be count: *a car, a child, an apple.*
- ✓ Can take singular o plural form.
There is a book on the table.
Those houses are very big.
- ✓ Go with *a/an* in the singular form.
Go with *some* in the plural form.
- ✓ Can be used along with:
some/any/many in the plural form.
There are some pears.

Uncountable Nouns

- ✓ Cannot be counted: *Sugar, information, water.*
- ✓ Always take singular form
There is some water spilt on the floor.
- ✓ Go with *some*.
- ✓ Can be used along with
some/any/much.
There is some information about the weather.
