Sentence and Fragments

A **sentence** is a group of words that express a complete thought.

A **fragment** is not a sentence. It doesn't express a complete thought. It is a group of words without a subject or a predicate.

Sentence: Our family took a trip to see relatives who live in New Providence.

Fragments: Our family. Took a trip to see relatives who live in New Providence.
