+ I AM
You/We/They ARE
He/She/It IS

- I AM NOT
You/We/They ARE NOT / AREN'T
He/She/It IS NOT / ISN'T

? AM I ?
ARE You/We/They ?
IS He/She/It ?

HAVE / HAS

+ I/You/We/They HAVE
He/She/It HAS

- I/You/We/They don't have
He/She/It doesn't have

? Do you/we/they have?
HAS Does he/she/it have?

*We don't use HAVE has with age and feelings: I am 11 years old / He is tired
