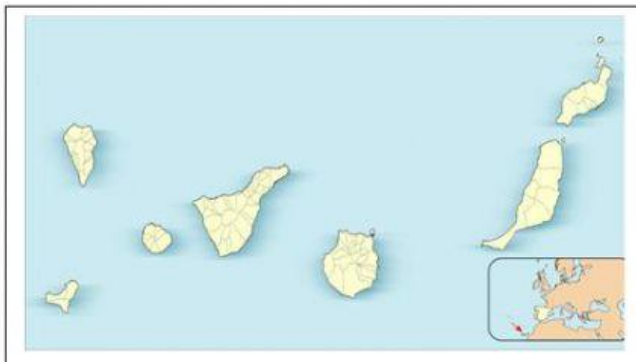


What is “La Noche de los Finaos” – Canary Islands

Where?

The Canary Islands are group of islands in the Atlantic, which are a part of Spain.



What and when? 0:

This old, traditional Canarian custom gathers the entire family to remember those who have passed away. It is celebrated from October 31st to November 2nd. (Do not confuse it with Halloween!)

The eldest female of the family organizes the event, tells old stories and myths.

During “El Baile de los Finaos” people go out to the streets to dance, sing folk songs, eat fried corn, chestnuts and almonds and drink honey-drinks. It happens during the night and it is the most exciting part of the festivities! :0



¿Hay Santos?

As the adults dance and sing, the children go out to knock of their neighbor's doors and ask: “¿Hay Santos?” Then, the children receive chestnuts, almonds and even traditional candy.

Almonds and Chestnuts Maybe not as yummy as candy, but still far healthier!
