He <sup>3</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (leave) home at five, <sup>4</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (go) to the guest house and <sup>5</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (meet) his tourist group. He helps them with their bags, and he <sup>6</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (put) extra food and water on his horse. They <sup>7</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (walk) all morning and <sup>8</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (stop) for lunch at about twelve. Gagan <sup>9</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (make) lunch for the group; he <sup>10</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (not eat) meat, so they have a simple vegetable dish. Then they <sup>11</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (walk) all afternoon to a new guest house before dark. Sometimes Gagan <sup>12</sup> \_\_\_\_\_ (not go) home for two to three days.
