

### The Simple Past Tense

When talking about an activity that has already happened or is in the Past, we use the Past Tense.

To form the Past Tense of most verbs, add **ed** to the end of the word.

For example: Sara **washed** the clothes this morning.

The boys **played** football yesterday.
