

1. Let's learn Simple Past in negative and interrogative sentences. Look !

Positive (+)	Negative (-)	Questions (?)
 Verb+ed <small>(Dance, Know)</small> He played tennis.	 + didn't + Verb <small>(Dance, Know)</small> He didn't play football.	Did +  + Verb? <small>(Dance, Know)</small> Did he play tennis?




In the negative we use **didn't** and the main verb without suffix -**ed**.
She didn't cry today.
~~She didn't cried today.~~

Anna **didn't work** yesterday. (The verb "work" is without "ed")

I **didn't finish** my homework.

The children **didn't play** football yesterday morning.

My parents **didn't travel** to Europe last holidays.



In *yes/no* questions we use **Did** at the beginning, then subject and main verb without suffix -**ed**.
Did she visit her grandma?
~~Did she visited her grandma?~~

- **Did** the boys **go** the club?(The verb "go" is without "ed")

Yes, they did / No, they didn't

- **Did** Peter **work** in a bank?

- **Yes, he did / NO, he didn't**

- **Did** Anna and Jake **help** their dad?

- **Yes, they did / No, they didn't**
