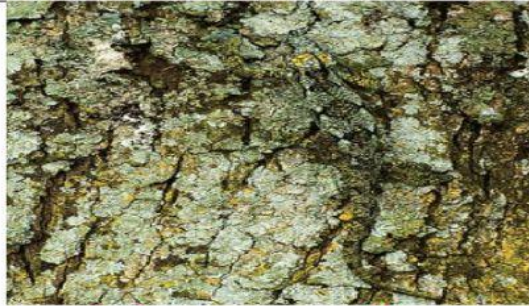
Topic: Mimicry and Camouflage

Mimicry is when insects can copy the look of a dangerous animal or natural object. They do this by imitating its coloring, sound and even movement.

Camouflage is a visual disguise that helps animals blend into their surroundings. A Camouflaged insect has coloring that matches its background. Both camouflage and mimicry help insects avoid being eaten.

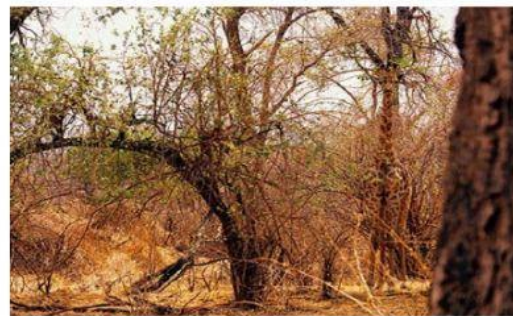

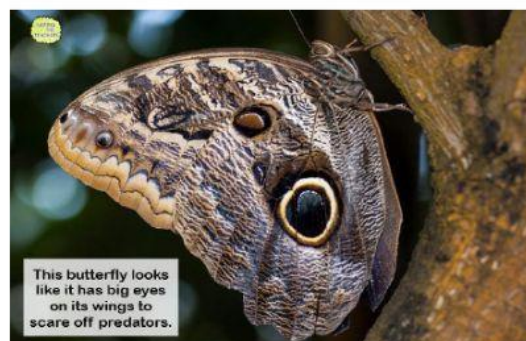
