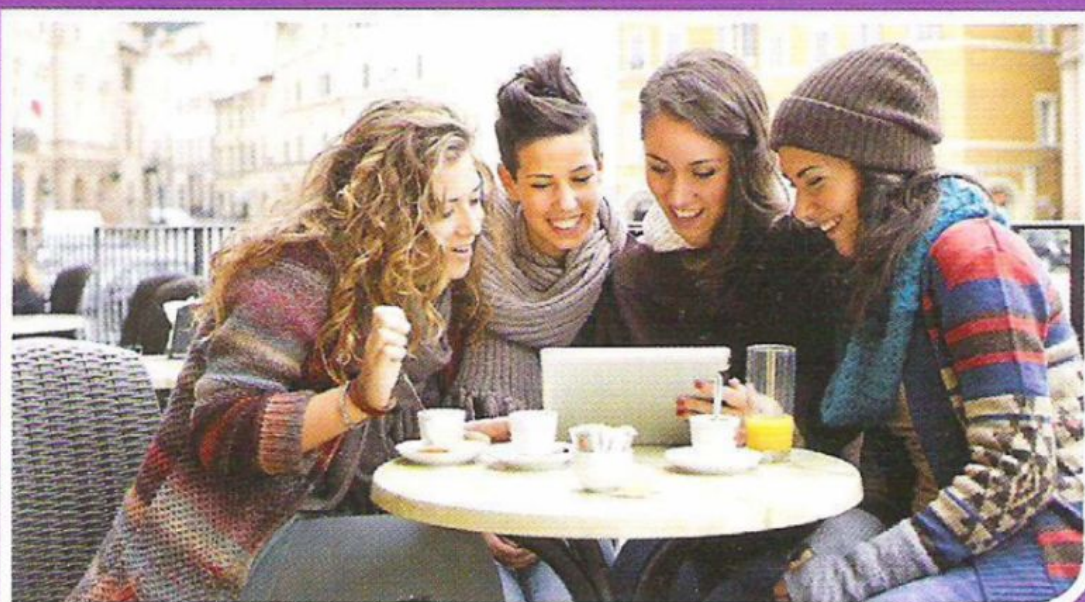
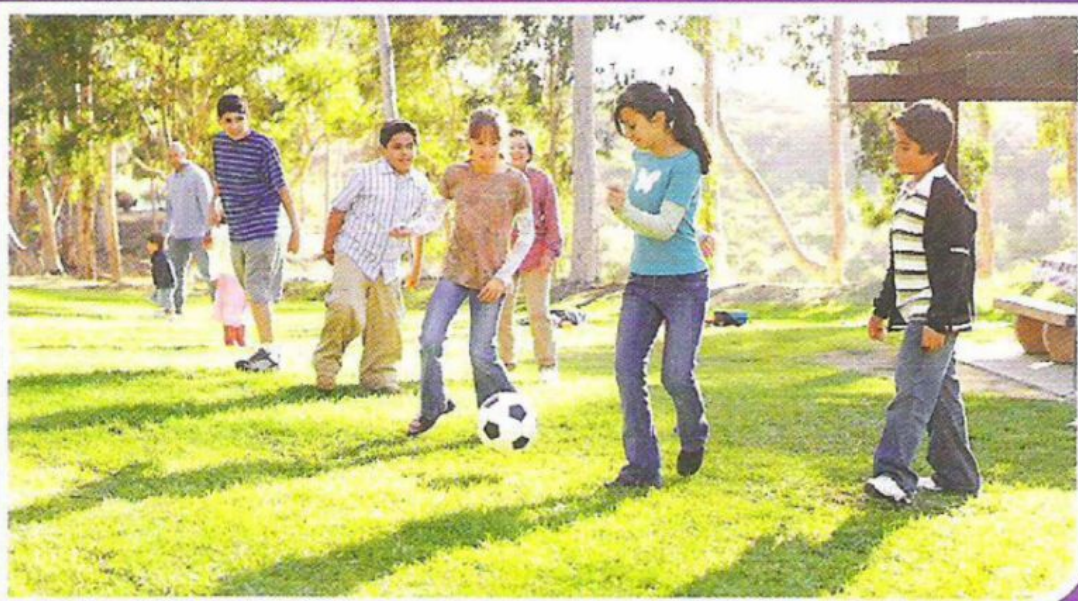
Student B: These pictures show different ways of spending New Year's Eve. I'd like you to compare and contrast the pictures and say how you like to spend New Year's Eve.
