AFFIRMATIVE

Pronouns	Verb "to be"	Catalan	Example
I (jo)	am	Jo sóc/jo estic	<i>I am tall</i> <i>I am in the school</i>
You (tu)	are	Tu ets/tu estàs	<i>You are my student</i> <i>You are at home</i>
he (ell)	is	Ell és/ell està	<i>He is a boy</i> <i>He is at home</i>
she (ella)	is	Ella és/ ella està	<i>She is a girl</i> <i>She is at home</i>
It (cosa animal)	is	Cosa animal és/ Cosa. animal està	<i>The dog is small</i> <i>The dog is in the garden</i>
We (nosaltres)	are	Nosaltres som Nosaltres estem	<i>We are students</i> <i>We are in the English class</i>
You (vosaltres)	are	Vosaltres sou Vosaltres esteu	<i>You are my family</i> <i>You are in your bedroom</i>
They (ells/elles)	are	Ells/elles són Ells/elles estan	<i>They are my friends</i> <i>They are very happy.</i>
