My favourite hobby is playing outside.

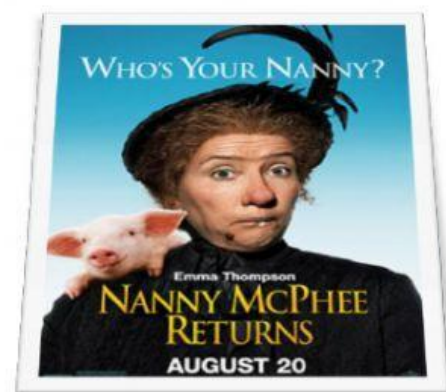
