After a couple of occasions where I got a bit ahead of my wife, she asked me to stay closer so I could help her down some of the awkward spots. The very next scramble we get to, I hopped down, turned around to make sure she's ok and then continued on thinking she was right behind me. After about 30 to 35 feet, I looked back to see her still on the rocks, staring at me with a look on her face that said «what... did I... just... ask... ???». Yea, she didn't quite see the humor in that one, and my guilty laughter definitely didn't help.
