

- ❖ This type of shelter keeps the weaver birds cool during hot days & warm during cold nights.
- ❖ They collect fog on their waxy layered back & guides it to their mouth.
- ❖ Before the blood from the heart reaches the brain it moves through the snout area where it is cooled.
- ❖ It lies flat in its burrow to cool down & it uses its tail as an umbrella.
- ❖ They move in a sidewinding way while keeping most of their body off the hot sand.
- ❖ It stands on 2 feet at a time, while the other 2 are in the air, avoiding the hot sand
