Steps: First, set up the cooling apparatus. Stir ice and salt in the larger container. Then, combine the ingredients. Mix together the milk, sugar, and vanilla in the glass bowl. After that, set this bowl in the tub filled with ice and rock salt, making sure that the salt water does not spill into the bowl. Next, mix the ice cream. Mix the ingredients in the small container vigorously. The salty ice mixture will make the mixture cool down until it turns into ice cream. It should take about 10 to 15 minutes to stir the ice cream using either method. Stir it until it is free from ice crystals and in the right consistency. 3. After that, use your fingers, add a cup of water, and keep on working until the mixture feels soft and smooth.
4. Then, boil some water in a rather large pot, at least about 2 liters.
5. Next step, start rolling the mixture into small meatballs.
6. **Finally**, put the meatballs into the boiling water. When they float up to the surface, the meatballs are ready to be served.
