

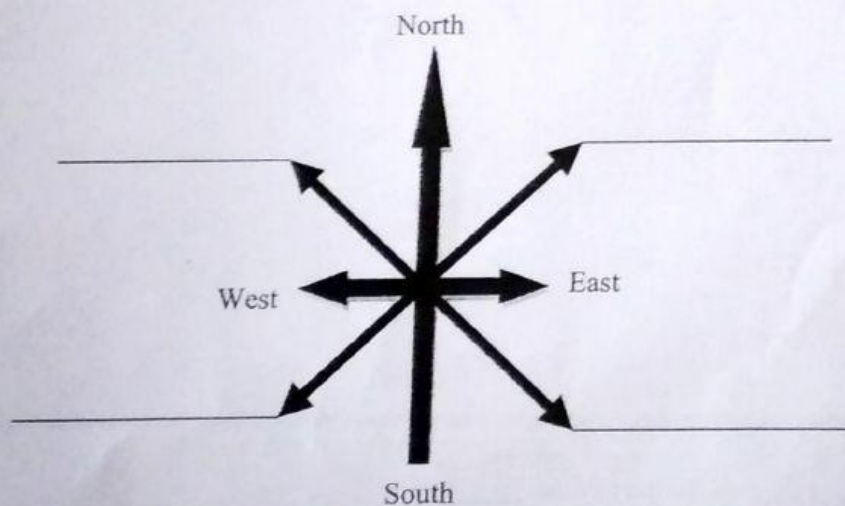
## SECTION 3 - DIRECTIONS (THE COMPASS)

### THE EIGHT INTERMEDIATE POINTS

What are the eight intermediate points of a compass?

In the eight point compass the four main cardinal points are sub-divided to form four new points. These new points are Northeast (NE), Northwest (NW), Southeast (SE), and Southwest (SW). Noticeably, the new points are taken from the cardinal points they fall between.
