

## Future Perfect

(subject + will + have + past participle)

### **An action that will happen before another action in the future**

- He \_\_\_\_\_ by the time he leaves the house. (prepare)
- His wife \_\_\_\_\_ dinner by the time he returns. (make)
- I \_\_\_\_\_ my book before we leave tonight. (finish)
- By the time he gets home, I \_\_\_\_\_ my homework. (do)
- Before you leave, I \_\_\_\_\_ my essay. (write)
- By the time you wake up, the thief \_\_\_\_\_ everything. (steal)

### **An action that will happen before a specific time in the future**

- By tomorrow, he \_\_\_\_\_ well. (sleep)
- By midnight they \_\_\_\_\_ too much too drink. (have)
- They \_\_\_\_\_ their renovations by May (finish)
- He \_\_\_\_\_ for us for 10 years next August. (work)
- Martin \_\_\_\_\_ his car by next Sunday. (sell)
- My mother \_\_\_\_\_ the whole house by lunchtime. (clean)

### **A state that will continue up to sometime in the future**

- Tomorrow he \_\_\_\_\_ sick for 2 weeks. (be)
- Next month my father \_\_\_\_\_ a widower for two years. (be)
- By 2020 I \_\_\_\_\_ alone for five years. (be)
