REPORTED QUESTIONS

We apply the same change in tenses, but when we report them, we do not write an auxiliary verb and question mark (?).

Yes/ No questions

Did we arrive to London? Diana asked.
Diana asked **IF** they **had** arrived to London.

Wh-/How questions

When did you leave Germany? Diana asked Steve.
Diana asked (Steve) **when** he **had** left Germany.

Yes/ No questions with verb TO BE

Are they the Amazons? Steve asked
Steve asked **IF** they **were** the Amazons.

Wh-/How questions with verb TO BE

Where is Ares? Diana asked
Diana asked **where** Ares **was**.
