

# Passive Voice



We use the passive voice when we don't know who did the action or the action itself is more important.

We can only form a passive sentence from an active sentence when there is an object in the active sentence.

The passive voice is less usual than the active voice. But sometimes a statement in passive is more polite than in active voice.

The passive is formed with the verb **to be** and the **past participle** of the main verb.

Present Simple ➔ **am / is / are + past participle**

Past Simple ➔ **was / were + past participle**

Present Perfect ➔ **have / has been + past participle**


Future Simple ➔ **will be + past participle**

The office **is cleaned** every day.

The office **was cleaned** at 5 o'clock.

The office **has already been cleaned**.

The office **will be cleaned** tonight.
