James Bond

The British writer Ian Fleming created James Bond in his 1953 novel Casino Royale. He wrote a series of books about the secret agent between 1953 and 1966. The books have sold more than 18 million copies in many different languages.

His code number is 007. The prefix 00 means that James Bond is licenced to kill, he can kill people if he needs to. Bond gets his code name at the start of the first novel, Casino Royale when he killed his enemies. He has killed more than 150 villains since.

He uses his intelligence, strength and high tech devices. In the early stories these were guns or explosives that looked like everyday objects (a watch, a pen for example). In later stories the devices became more sophisticated and included X-ray glasses and a jetpack.

There have been 23 official James Bond films. The first film was Dr No in 1962, starring Sean Connery. The Bond films are the second most successful series of films in the history of cinema. The most successful is the Harry Potter series. In fact, half of the world's population has seen a James Bond film at the cinema, on TV or on DVD.

Six actors have played the part of James Bond. The current Bond is English actor Daniel Craig but most people's favourite is Sean Connery.
