

## Simple Present Tense

Affirmative	Interrogative	Negative
I work	Do I work?	I <b>don't</b> work
You work	Do you work?	You <b>don't</b> work
He work <b>s</b>	<b>Does</b> he work?	He <b>doesn't</b> work
She work <b>s</b>	<b>Does</b> she work?	She <b>doesn't</b> work
It Work <b>s</b>	<b>Does</b> it Work?	It <b>doesn't</b> work
We work	Do we work?	We <b>don't</b> work
You work	Do you work?	You <b>don't</b> work
They work	Do they work?	They <b>don't</b> work

THIRD PERSON SINGULAR (HE, SHE, IT = singular subject)

Rule: We add S to the end of the verb in the 3rd person singular affirmative. In the following cases we add -ES.



## THE PRESENT SIMPLE

### AFFIRMATIVE

Verbs ending in:

- -ch
- -sh
- -x
- -ss
- -o
- consonant + y

+ -es

We **work** in an office  
 You **work** in an office  
 They **work** in an office



### ATTENTION SPECIAL CASES

He **watches** television.  
 He **washes** the dishes.  
 She **fixes** radios.  
 He **misses** his girlfriend.  
 She **goes** to school.  
 She **does** his homework.  
 He **studies** English.

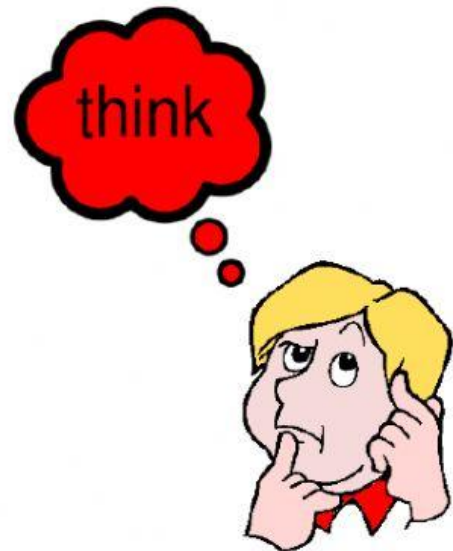
