A: Good. And I

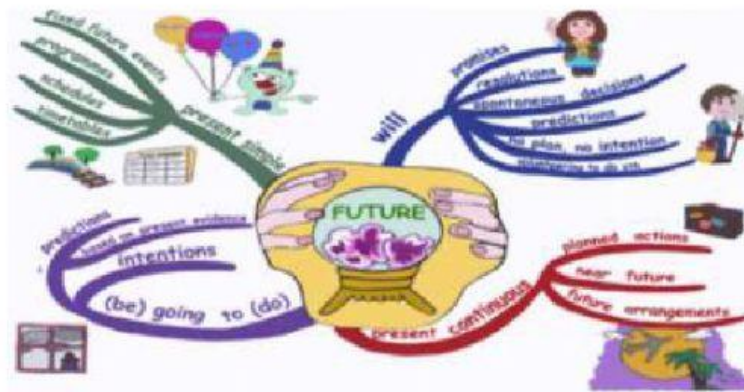
-'ll have prepared
