## The Miracle Worker

- 1. You will be acting like a detective using your imagination and making inferences. First, choose a character from the play.
- 2. Using the directions below, start with the known facts, then infer to supplement your information as follows:
  - a. <u>Right arm:</u> write any information you know or what you can infer about your character's personality.
- b. <u>Left arm:</u> include 3 significant quotes by the character and explain why they are significant. If you are doing Helen, you will need to include quotes from other characters that say something about her actions/feelings, or something from stage directions. Include page numbers.
- c. <u>Head area:</u> write about their relationships with other characters (must include at least 2). Use specific details from the text to back up your thinking.
- d. <u>Left leg:</u> choose another quote from your character (must be different from the left arm quotes). Underline specific words in the quote that stand out, and explain what those underlined words show (this is similar to the word choice activity you did last week).
- e. <u>Right leg:</u> write about 2 significant events for your character in the play so far.
  - f. Heart/chest area: write any hopes and wishes (make inferences here!)

Lastly, color your person to look like the character. Be careful to not color too darkly over your writing. Make sure your name is on the back.
