- 1) Which of the following are adjacent angles.

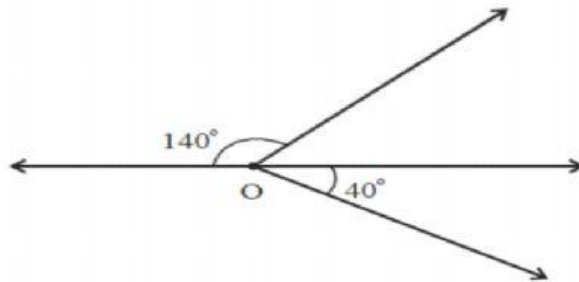

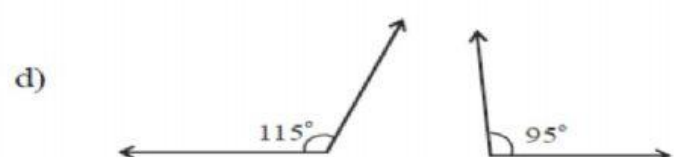
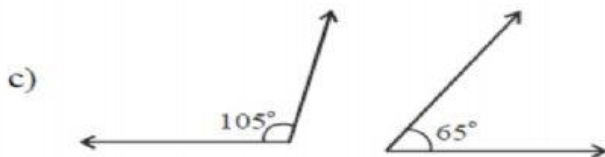
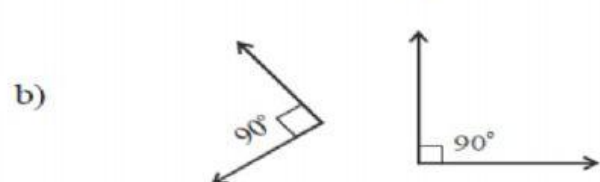
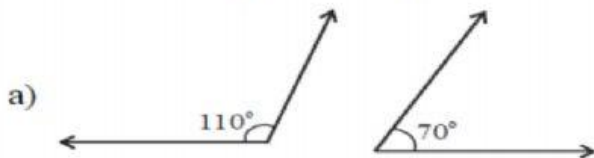
- 3) Does $\angle ABC$ and $\angle DBE$ adjacent angles? Give reasons.
