1- Tenses: Simple present/present perfect/ past simple /past continuous/past perfect

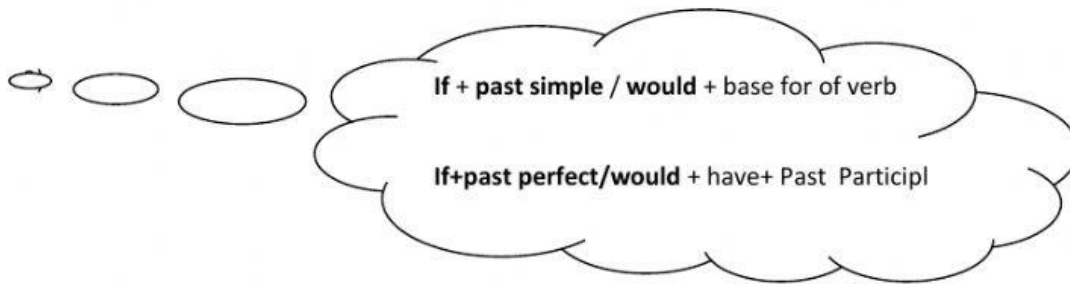
- a) How long \_\_\_\_\_ you \_\_\_\_\_ (study) English?
