1. Tim has a science project. He collected 433 cans on Monday. He collected 203 more on Tuesday. How many cans did Tim collect in all?
2. Gina traveled 450 miles to her grandmother's house in two days. She traveled 50 more miles on Saturday than on Sunday. How many miles did she travel on Saturday and Sunday?
3. Maria practiced the recorder for 15 minutes on Sunday. She practiced 30 minutes on Monday. How many minutes did Maria practice altogether?
4. Bob has a sticker book with 5, 633 stickers. His dad bought him another book with 2, 000 stickers. What is the total number of stickers Bob has now?
