

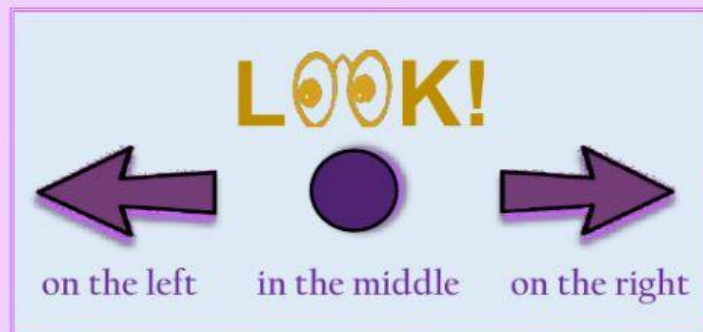
A photo of my family
