Bills and Coins



Today we will learn about the value of coins and dollar bill notes up to \$100.

\$ - is used to show how much dollars. It is put before the number.

For example: \$4 \$23 \$85 \$99 \$1

¢ - is used to show how much cents. It is put after a number.

For example: 5¢ 25¢ 50¢ 99¢ 75¢

A full stop is used to separate the dollars from the cents when writing.
