Use **simple present** to talk about things that are **true**.

- I **speak** English.

To make a **negative statement** with **I, you, we** and **they**, use **do not** or **don't** + the verb.

- I **don't** speak German.

To ask information, use the question words **what, when**, and **where + do**.

- **What do** you like to do?
- **When do** you study?
- **Where do** you go for the Holiday?
