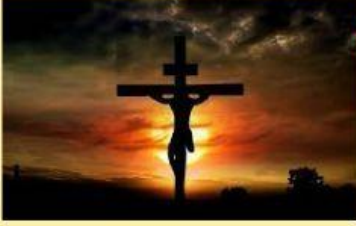


EASTER TRADITIONS IN ENGLAND.



GOOD FRIDAY: it's the first day of Easter holidays. It celebrates the crucifixion of Jesus Christ.



HOT CROSS BUNS: sweet small bread made of flour, eggs and fruit, with a cross at the top.



PALM SUNDAY: This feast commemorates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Palm Sunday marks the first day of Holy Week.



EASTER SUNDAY: This Sunday Christians celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ. In England there are 'eggs hunts'.



EASTER EGGS: It means that life comes again after Winter with spring. People decorate eggs. They are used as gifts. Nowadays most of them are made of chocolate for children.

EASTER BUNNY: It's a rabbit that brings a basket with Easter eggs and candies to children like Santa Claus brings present at Christmas. The rabbit hides the eggs in gardens, and children must find them.



EGG HUNT: Children typically collect the eggs that Easter Bunny hid in a basket. When the hunt is over, parents will give prizes for the largest number of eggs collected, for the largest or smallest egg...
