- 2) Marvin (come) home, (switch) on the computer and checked his emails.
- 3) Nobody (listen) while the teacher (explain) the tenses.
- 4) The telephone (ring) while I (have) my bath.
- 5) While we (do) a sight-seeing tour, our friends (lie) on the beach.
- 6) He (wake) up and (look) at his watch.
- 7) I (light) the fire at 6.00 and it (burn) brightly when Tom came in at 7.00.
- 8) When I (arrive) the lecture had already started and the professor (write) on the overhead projector.
- 9) I (make) a cake when the light (go) out. I had to finish it in the dark.
- 10) When the war (break) out we (live) in Warsaw.
- 11) I (not, want) to meet Paul so when he entered the room I (leave).
- 12) He (watch) TV when the phone rang. Very unwillingly he (turn) down the sound and went to answer it.
- 13) The thief (sneak) into the house, (steal) the jewels and left without a trace.
- 14) She (drive) very quickly when the accident (happen).
- 15) He was very polite. Whenever his wife (enter) the room he (stand) up.
- 16) The admiral was playing bowls when he (receive) news of the invasion. He (insist) on finishing the game.
- 17) My dog (walk) along quietly when Mr Pitt's Pekinese (attack) him.
- 18) He (wear) always a raincoat and (carry) an umbrella when he was walking to the office.
- 19) I (share) a flat with him when we were students. Since I remember him he (complain) always about my untidiness!
- 20) He (realize) suddenly that he (travel) in the wrong direction.
- 21) We (wait) just Mary when John (come).
- 22) He (play) the guitar outside her house when someone opened the window and (throw) out a bucket of water.
- 23) I (try) to open the letter when the wind (blow) it out of my hand.
- 24) As it (rain) very hard, the referee (decide) not to play the match.
- 25) Unfortunately when I (arrive) Ann (leave), so we only had time for a few words.
- 26) The burglar (open) the safe when he (hear) footsteps.
- 27) When I (look) for my passport I (find) this old photograph.
- 28) At half past nine she (do) still her homework.
- 29) She (wear) a pink summer frock when I (meet) her yesterday.
- 30) You (look) very busy when I saw you last night. What you (do)?
