The energy needed to start a reaction

ACTIVE SITE

The molecule that the enzyme acts upon

PRODUCT

A protein that helps molecules to react with each other

CATALYST

The substance produced at the end of a chemical reaction

DENATURED

The area on the enzyme where the substrate gets attached.

ACTIVATION ENERGY

A condition when the shape of the active site is changed and the substrate can no longer fit.

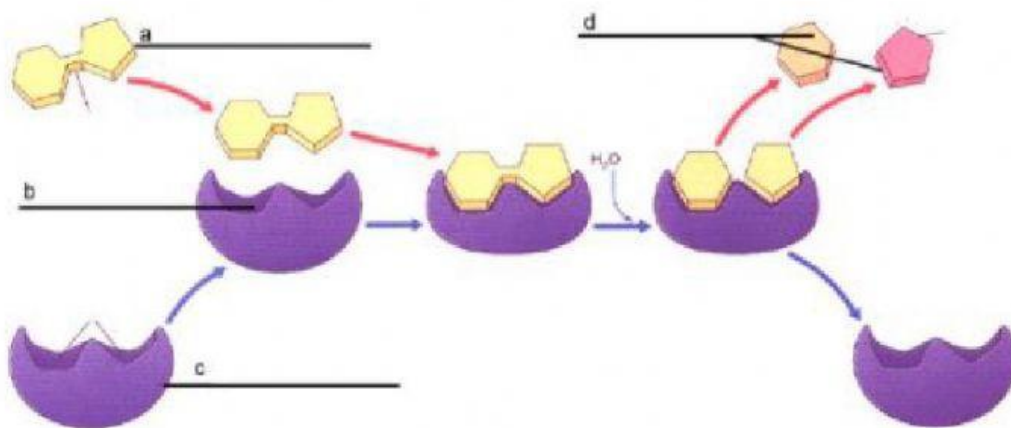
