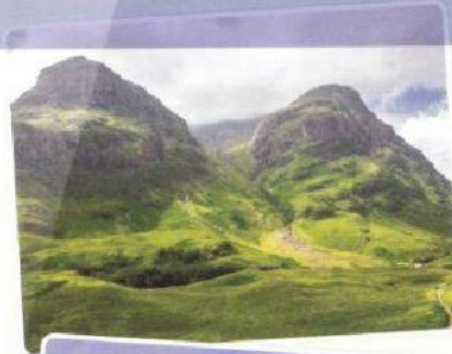
My holidays in Scotland
