Gas **fumes** from cars and smoke from factory **chimneys** pollute the air.

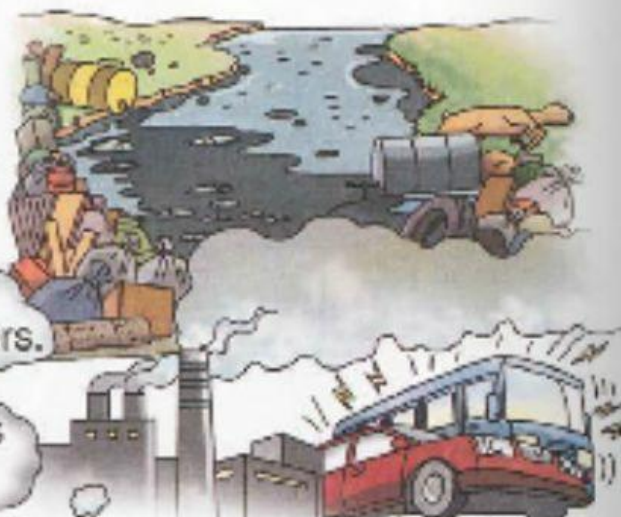
Factories should recycle water and stop releasing **chemicals** into our lakes and rivers.
