Write your **article** in about **100 words**.

Example answer

Do you like Italian food? I love it, so I was delighted when my parents took me to Fratelli's restaurant last weekend.

The good thing about Fratelli's is that there's plenty of choice. You can either have pizza or pasta, or a meat or fish dish. Everything is delicious, except the salads, which aren't very exciting.

The only bad thing about the restaurant is that there's no music, so it's very quiet! But on the whole, I would recommend it, and I'm sure you'd love the food. Do you think I should ask them to put some music on next time I go?

Ask an opening question to make your reader feel involved.

Answer all the questions in the task. You can choose the order in which you include the information.

Use connectors to link ideas.

Use adjectives to make your writing more interesting.

Invite other people to give their opinions.
