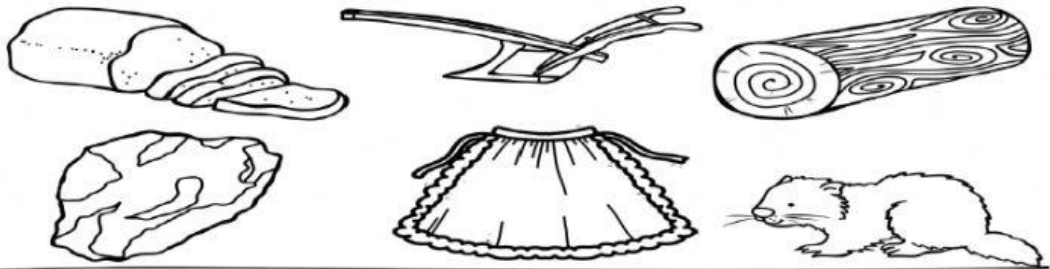
The Quakers were a different religious group.



The Middle colonies were called the bread basket colonies.

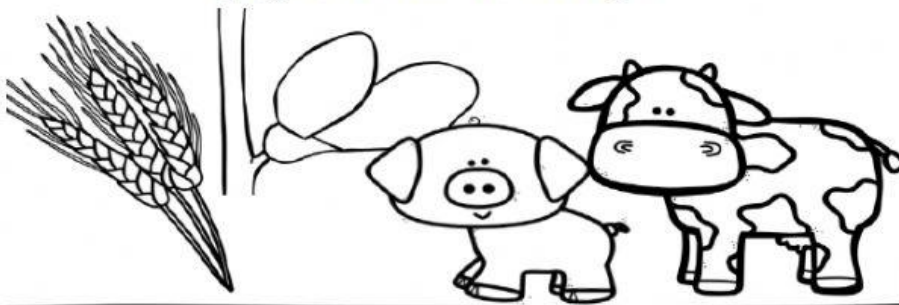


The goods made in these colonies were bread, timber, fur, coal, iron, plows, cloth, and more.
