Multiplication Maze

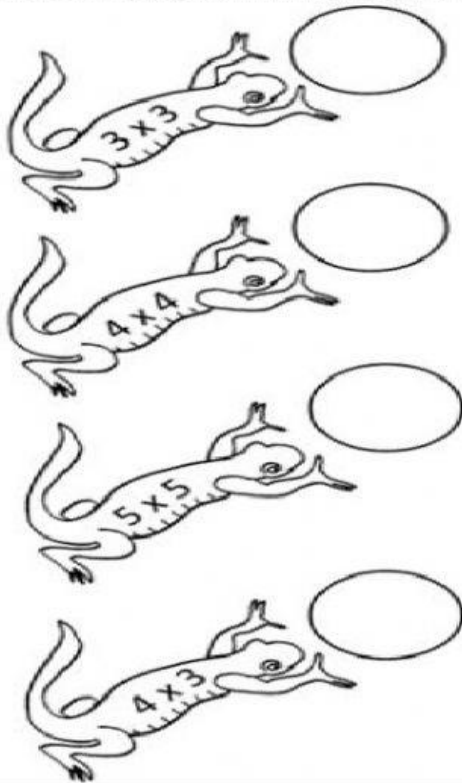
Work the problems as you travel through the maze. If your answer is an odd number, you may be going the wrong way!

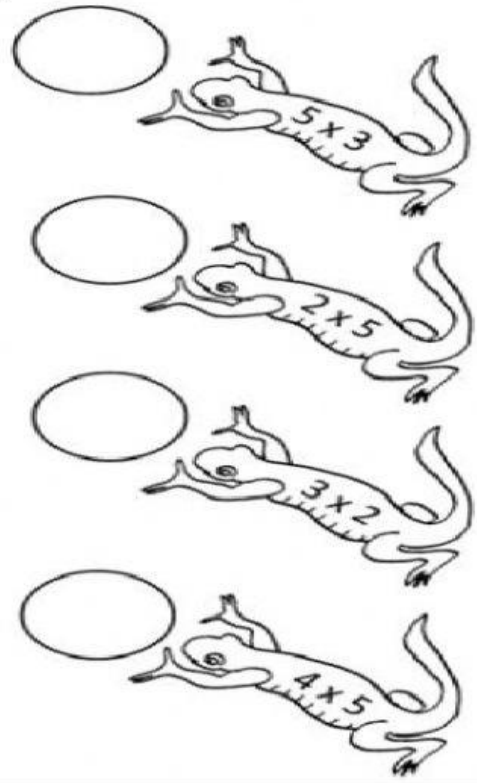
