Use *when* to ask about the time something happens. Use the propositions *at, in, on* and *from . . . to* to talk about time.

Use *at* for a definite time.
Use *in* for months and parts of the day.
Use *on* for days and dates.
Use *from . . . to* for a period of time.

at	1:30 night	In	the morning January	on	Saturday the weekend	from	2:00 p.m. Tuesday	to	3:00 p.m. Friday

ANSWERS


I **go** to work **at** 8 o'clock.
