Cecelia Ahern (born 1981) is a bestselling Irish novelist. She has written *PS, I Love You*, *Where Rainbows End* (also known as *Love, Rosie*) and *If You Could See Me Now*. Born in Dublin, Ahern is now published in nearly fifty countries, and has sold over 25 million copies of her novels worldwide. *Love, Rosie* was adapted as a motion film in 2014.
