Susan B. Anthony was born on February 15th, 1820, near Adams, Massachusetts. She was the second of eight children born to Daniel and Lucy Read Anthony. Susan benefited from growing up in a Quaker community, where she was encouraged to

express herself freely. Her father made sure that his daughters received excellent educations, equal to that of his sons.

Susan became a teacher and taught for ten years before she began her reform career as a temperance activist in 1848. She met Elizabeth Cady Stanton in 1851. Her friendship with Elizabeth turned into a working partnership that lasted until their deaths. Susan was inspired by Elizabeth to fight for women's suffrage.

Susan traveled extensively to campaign for women's issues, but she was also interested in anti-slavery issues. In 1856, she was hired by the American Anti-Slavery Society to speak out against slavery. During the Civil War, Susan lobbied for the freedom of African Americans. Throughout the 1870s and 1880s, Susan felt it was her duty to educate society about the importance of getting the vote for women. She continued traveling and lecturing, and even went to Europe to stimulate cooperation between U.S. and foreign women reformers.

Susan B. Anthony worked tirelessly throughout her life for the causes she supported. She died at the age of 86. It would take fourteen more years for women to get the right to vote.
