<b>Keyboard</b>	<b>A.</b> A hand-held pointing device that moves a pointed arrow on a computer screen.
<b>Joystick</b>	<b>B.</b> A device made up of a moveable ball that is rotated with your figures or the palm of the hand mainly found on laptops.
<b>Microphone</b>	<b>C.</b> A device used to record sound and then save as a sound file on the computer.
<b>Voice Recognition</b>	<b>D.</b> A device that you can touch with your finger to enter information.
<b>Mouse</b>	<b>E.</b> A device used to take pictures.
<b>Light pen</b>	<b>F.</b> A device used to type data for use by a wide range of application on the computer.
