

WRITE AN ARTICLE

STRUCTURE	
TITLE	Engage the reader. Catchy. Provocative.
INTRODUCTION	Introduce topic. Engages the reader further. Usually poses a question to be answered at the end of the article.
MAIN BODY	Develop ideas: E.g. Positive aspects Negative aspects
CONCLUSION	Give answer to previous question. Give your opinion/point of view. Take sides.
