Reporting Statements

TENSE CHANGES

When reporting someone's words we usually move one tense further into the past.

<u>takes</u>	→ took	→ had taken
<u>is taking</u>	→ was taking	→ had been taking
<u>has/have</u> taken	→ had taken	→ X
<u>will take</u>	→ would take	→ X
<u>can take</u>	→ could take	→ X
<u>may take</u>	→ might take	→ X

TIME EXPRESSIONS

today	→ that day	tonight	→ that night
yesterday	→ the day before / the previous day	now	→ then
tomorrow	→ the next day / the following day	last week	→ the week before / the previous

this → **that** these → **those** here → **there**

I → **he / she** (*) we → **they** (*) you → **me/us/her/him**

OTHER CHANGES

Some changes depend on the context of the sentence we are reporting. (*)

A.- What did the couple say to each other over dinner yesterday?

Example: 1) She said (that) their daughter was pregnant.
