### ZERO Conditional

Used to talk about things that are generally true or scientific facts.

### IF CLAUSE

+

### MAIN CLAUSE

If + present simple ...

present simple

If the weather is good,  
If it rains,  
If you freeze water,

I go to the beach.  
the grass gets wet.  
it turns into ice.

### FIRST Conditional

Used to talk about a possible condition and its probable result in the future.

If + present simple ...

will + infinitive

If the weather is good tomorrow,  
If you don't hurry,  
If I have enough time,

I will go to the beach.  
you will miss the train.  
I will exercise.

### SECOND Conditional

Used to talk about an unlikely or hypothetical condition and its probable result now or in the future.

If + past simple ...

would + infinitive

If the weather was good,  
If I had a lot of money,  
If you went to bed earlier,

I would go to the beach.  
I would travel around the world.  
you wouldn't be so tired.

### THIRD Conditional

Used to talk about an imaginary condition and its probable result in the past.

If + past perfect ...

would have + past participle

If the weather had been good,  
If you hadn't eaten so much,  
If I had studied harder,

I would have gone to the beach.  
you wouldn't have felt sick.  
I would have passed the exam.
