Like

Form: like + noun phrase

I **like** Sarah but I **don't like** her brother much.

Yes/ no questions

Do you like pasta?

She really **likes** the singing of Luciano Pavarotti. (he, she, it likes)

like + -ing

I **like swimming** before breakfast.

He **likes telling** jokes.

like + to-infinitive

She **likes to go** and see her parents at the weekend.

I **don't like to cycle** in the dark.
