BEING OPEN

Have you ever wondered what kind of people famous athletes are? Are they like us, regular people, or are they role models in any life situation? One of the most honest and sincere books about 3.1. of a professional athlete is Open, the autobiography of Andre Agassi. Whether you like sport or not, you will find it difficult to put 3.2. down. The story of one of the best tennis players in history starts when he is just a child whose father makes him train really hard and sends him to a tennis camp when Andre is only thirteen. He soon starts to rebel: he dyes 3.3., wears earrings and dresses like a rocker, not a tennis player. However, his talent emerges when he wins Wimbledon in 1992 and immediately becomes a star. Agassi is open and sincere in his book when he talks 3.4., about his successes and good times, but also about his failures, loss of confidence, and his brief marriage to Brooke Shields. However, he soon overcomes his troubles, comes back to 3.5., meets Steffi Graf, his wife and the mother of their two children, and retires from professional sport because of health problems. It's the real story of a man who happened to be a professional athlete and is completely open about it.
