h.-noun. An amount of something that is available to be used.

i.-adjective. Able to continue without causing damage to the environment.

j.-verb. To use time, energy, goods etc.

k.-verb. To completely get rid of something that is unnecessary or unwanted.

l.-adjective. Used when you want to emphasize that you mean all of a group, period of time, amount etc **SYN** whole.
