

The Mini Space Museum

One way to spend the weekend with your family or friends is with a visit to the Mini Space Museum. Since 2010, the Mini Space Museum has been educating the public about space frontier and exploration

The Mini Space Museum has various exhibits, an experiment room and a large hall where the public can get up close to replicas of rockets, space robots and satellites used by scientists around the world to study and explore space. However, the highlight of the museum has to be its theatre. It is actually a virtual reality stimulator theatre which is able to give the public amazing views of the planets, galaxies and stars. The museum screens two documentaries daily.

The documentaries change every six months. There are two screenings each day; at 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. The public are advised to book early as tickets run out quickly. The theatre can only seat 60 people. Ticket prices are RM15 for adults and RM8 for children.

The Mini Space Museum is open every day from 9.30 a.m. to 5.30 p.m except Fridays. Entry is free. The museum is well-equipped to make your visit comfortable. There are bathrooms, an information counter, a prayer room and a cafeteria.

It also has friendly staff positioned at different exhibits to help you with your questions.
