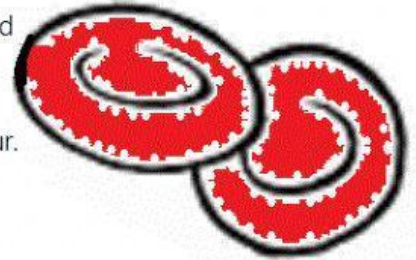

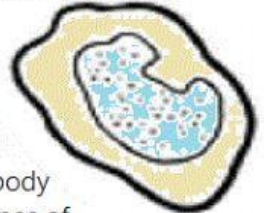


White Blood Cells

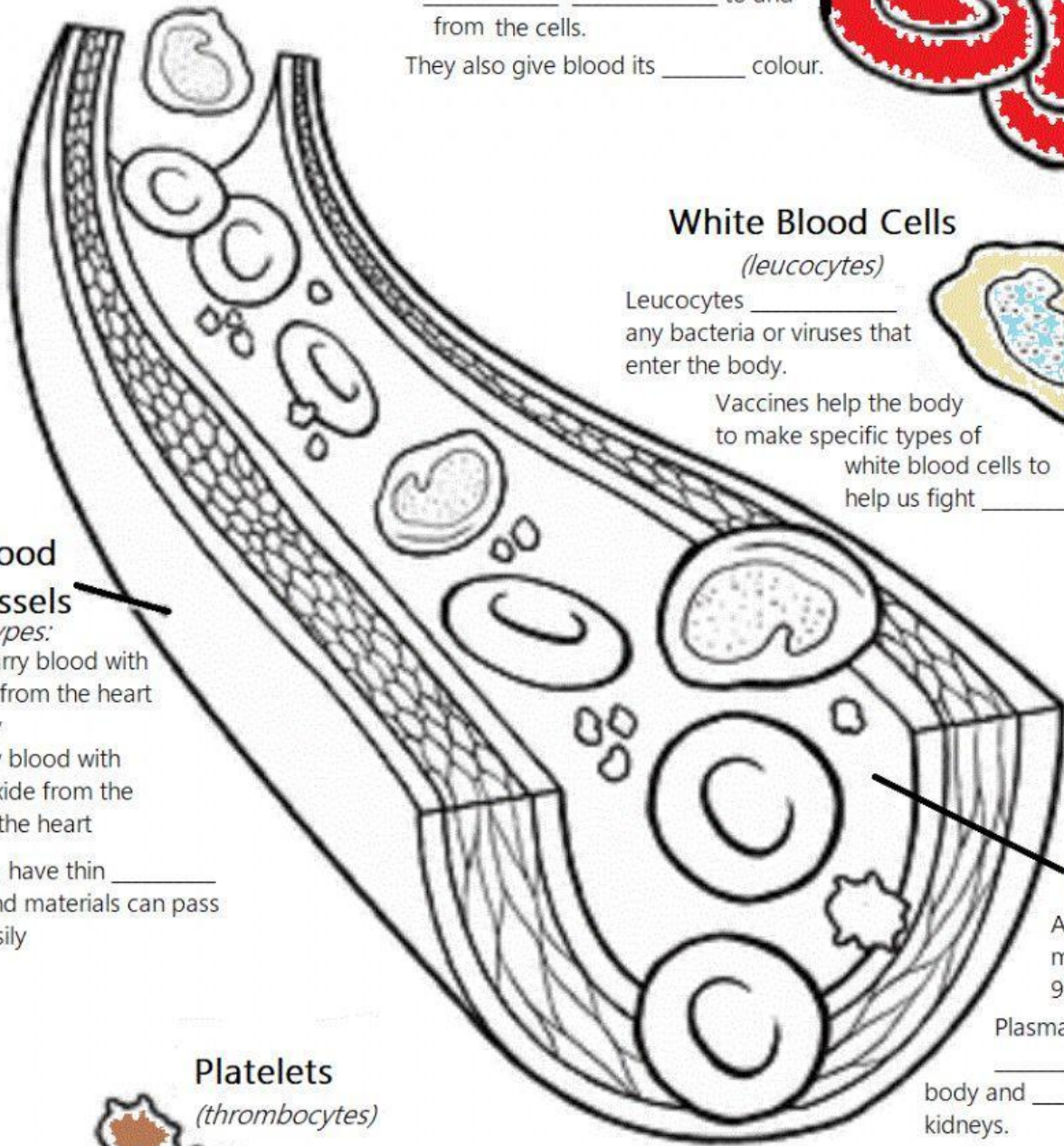

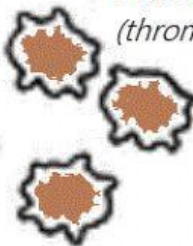
