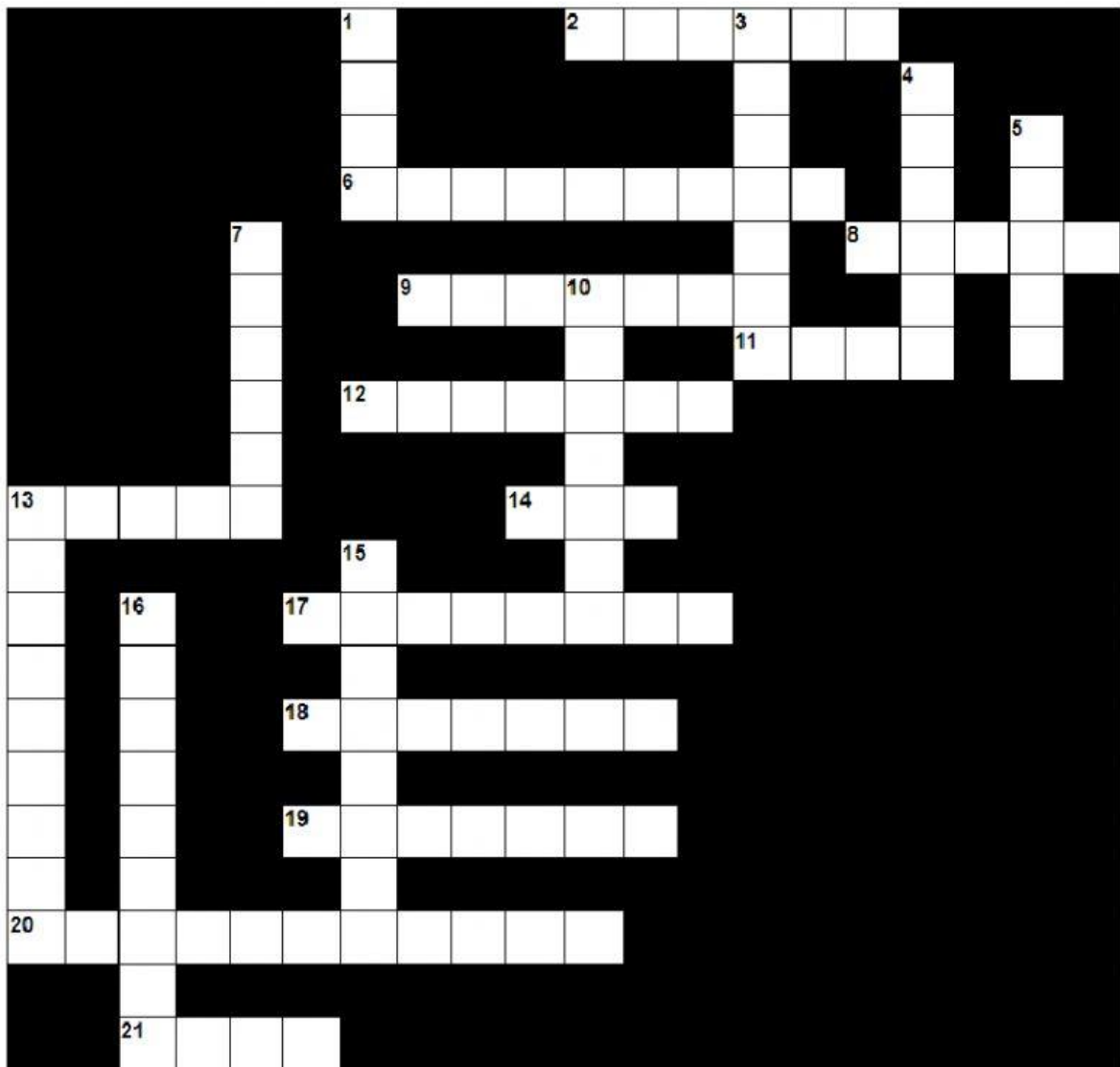




Across:
