

Leucocytes (white blood cells)

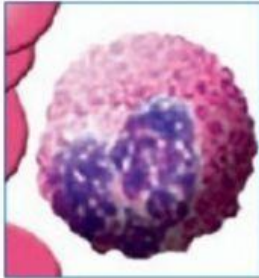
(have granular cytoplasm and lobed nuclei)

(have clear cytoplasm and their nuclei are not lobed)



Phagocytic granulocytes that engulf and digest bacteria and dead cells

Release enzymes to fight inflammation in allergic reactions; also kill parasitic worms

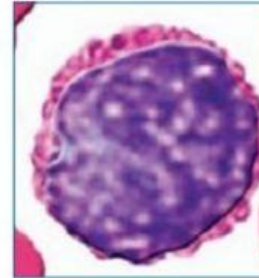
Agranulocytes

- Secrete heparin to prevent blood from clotting

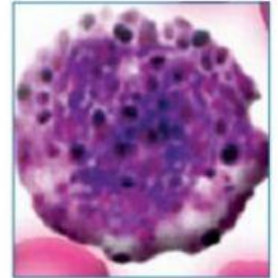
Basophils
